



# SEED LIST 2021

*Kia ora koutou seed savers!*

This year's seed list is a bit later coming out – apologies. We have been sent some great seeds over the last year, and have some new varieties in the list (marked with an asterisk: \*). The inventory took some time!

First of all I want to tautoko the efforts of some of our dedicated seed savers – you know who you are – without these growers there wouldn't be much on our list. It is because of these people that we have so many seeds to share. Ngā mihi!

Some of the very special seeds from our network, particularly those given to us by Henry Harrington in 1999 (which kicked off the Southland Seed Savers Network) are the focus of our seed saving efforts this year – we have sent them off to our regular, very experienced seed savers for them to grow and (all going well) bulk up for us, so we will have plenty available for everyone next year. Super exciting!

You may notice that this year's seed list is called a 'seed list' not a 'seed catalogue'. This is to encourage all our members to remember that what is on the list needs to be replenished by our members or it will no longer be available. A 'catalogue' allows us to think that our relationship is purely a financial transaction – money is exchanged for seeds. This isn't ideally how a seed saving network works. However, in saying that, we have been given large quantities of beans and tomatoes by the Heritage Food Crops Research Trust, who have been importing a wide range of these from the United States and researching which are the healthiest for us to grow. It is not likely that all 37 climbing beans available will grow well in Southland (they are mostly originally from Central America), but some may – these are the ones we really want sent back! So if you are a keen bean, please grow a bunch of different varieties and save the seeds of those that succeed!

As for previous years, membership costs a donation of at least \$5 and seed packs are \$1 each. Anything more you are able to donate is always appreciated, as we are a not-for-profit community group. If you have sent us seeds within the last year, consider yourself already a member!

<p><i>Note: You can more or less predict the viability of the seed by comparing the date on the seeds with their viability. E.g. Lyon leek was saved in 2018. Leek seed viability is 2 – 4 years, so the seed should germinate this year, but may not be great. The fresher the seed, the better. You may wish to try and ‘resurrect’ a variety that is getting a bit old: if no-one does this it won’t appear on next year’s list!</i></p>
